







You may know that our program is nationally accredited through NAEYC, a level of quality that only 8% of preschools in the country maintain. Through NAEYC we must meet standards in the areas of curriculum, assessment, administration, environment, and more. September 20 our national assessor came for our five year renewal visit! As a result, I had to postpone our SUBSTITUTE TEACHER TRAINING that had been scheduled for Friday morning. I will let you know when that will be rescheduled.

OF THE MONTH Volunteers are at ministry at Bethel. There are so many people of so many ages who do so much to serve God and God's people.


