Friends of Bethel,

We are all well aware of the spread of the Corona/Covid-19 Virus.

As leaders at Bethel, we have been paying close attention to what we see is going on around us, and we are in dialogue with the medical community and local authorities.

In response, we have put together a plan for this weekend. We hope it will offer some options for you, and keep us all safe:

- · First, we encourage all people who are not feeling well, or are at risk, to stay home.
- Please note, our 8:00am Sunday service will be broadcast on WEVR Radio (AM 1550/ FM 106.3). Our 9:30 Sunday service will be streaming live on our Bethel Facebook page (facebook.com/blchudson/)
- Sunday School classes, our nursery, and our 2nd grade milestone are postponed for this weekend
- We will offer all four worship services this weekend for those who feel confident in coming. We encourage some from the 9:30 hour to consider shifting to one of our smaller services (at 5:00pm, 8:00am, and 11:00am)
- We are suspending the shaking of hands at all points of our services (as well as before and after).
- · Offering plates will be put in a stationary location, and not passed
- · Communion will be offered as an option only after each service (and we will use small cups rather than intinction)
- · No refreshments (coffee & cookies) will be served after any of our services this weekend.

Please know, we have increased the scope and intensity of our cleaning and sanitation of our worship spaces and narthexes at both campuses.

AND FINALLY, if there is a confirmed case here at Bethel, or in our Preschool (or sooner, if necessary) we will:

- · Suspend all public worship and gatherings
- · Provide radio and live streaming worship only
- · Cancel any meetings taking place at Bethel's Campuses

We will reassess as we go each week, friends.
