What is Via de Cristo?

Via de Cristo originated as Cursillo[©] in the 1940's in Majorca in Spain. Cursillo[©] (kur-see-yo) is a Spanish word for "short intense course". The movement spread quickly and has been adopted by many different denominations around the world. Although its known by many different names today (http://cursillos.ca/en/liens.htm), the essentials of this 3 day retreat remain the same. The method is a highly structured three-day weekend designed to strengthen and renew the faith of Christian people and bring them to a new awareness of living in God's grace. The method is based on the fundamentals of Christianity, concentrating on the person and teachings of Jesus Christ.

The Lutheran movement is called "Via de Cristo" (www.viadecristo.org). This is Spanish meaning "Way of Christ". A Via de Cristo weekend is three days long, beginning on Thursday evening and ending on Sunday afternoon. The participants live, study, worship and commune together daily. Through 14 progressive talks, Via de Cristo gives attendees a living understanding of basic Christian truths. There is music and singing, food and fellowship, a time for laughter and a time for prayer.

Keep an open mind and heart in making your decision to attend Via de Cristo. Like you, many attendees wondered if they should go. Now that they have attended, they want to share this wonderful gift from God with others. Please understand that their experience attending Via de Cristo was unique, and all the conversations in the world are not a substitute for your weekend. You need to experience a weekend yourself to obtain its full and life enriching value.

Via de Cristo Participant Guidelines

Joshua 1:8

- DO NOT SUBMIT ANY MONEY WITH THIS APPLICATION. After the applicant has been accepted into the weekend, a registration fee of \$30.00 per person will be required. Additional instructions will be provided at that time.
- Via de Cristo is an ecumenical program. Members of any Christian church are eligible to participate provided that a pastor from that church has at one time attended a Cursillo[©] type weekend.
- Once a church has been established as a Cursillo[®] church it can continue to send both lay and clergy to weekends. The church remains a Cursillo[®] church even after the Cursillo[®] pastor retires or takes another call.
- The first attending pastor is required to have one lay couple from that church attend at the same time for the purpose of establishing community.
- A person must be over 21 years old to attend a Via de Cristo weekend. An exception is made for married or engaged couples where one person is less than 21.
- Via de Cristo is open to both single and married people. However, both husband and wife must attend the same pair of weekends.
- Weekends fill quickly. Clergy from churches, which have not participated in the past, are given preference in the application selection.
- The weekends are operated in pairs. Men attend the first weekend and women attend one week later. Both weekends are held at the same site.
- Weekends are held in a host church where all of the participants and Via de Cristo team members live together as a community.
- The weekends begin at 7:30pm on Thursday and end at approximately 5:00pm on Sunday. Complete attendance is required for the entire weekend.
- Each weekend is presented by a team, which has gathered and trained together for that weekend only.
 The same format and time schedule is followed for each weekend.
